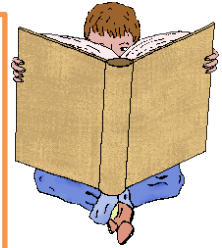


Music

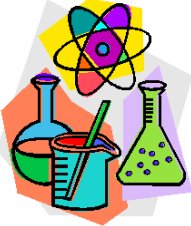
Literacy

We will be learning to narrate, perform and write different text types, our current one being *Journey to the River Sea*. Regular practice of our texts embeds children's learning.

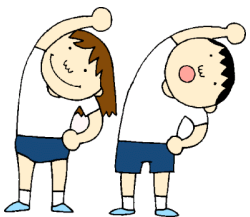


In science and RE...
