Summer Term

Literacy

We will begin by exploring adventure stories and considering patterns in the story of 'The Chicken and the Egg'. We will think about our choice of adjectives and begin to experiment with dialogue. Later in the term, we will be researching minibeasts and writing non-chronological reports about them.

Maths

This term we are looking at the relationship between addition and subtraction. We will use arrays to solve times and division problems and we will also look at totalling money.

Art/DT

In art the children will be studying the work of 'Andy Goldsworthy' and like him be inspired by nature to create our nature art.

Geography/History

The children will be exploring their local environment and learning about the different types of minibeasts and their habitats. As minibeast detectives they will be discussing and recording what they find.

Music

Children will discuss basic musical terms - fast, slow, loud, quiet and understanding how music can tell a story.

Hatching Chicks

Every year, Year 1 children are lucky enough to take part in a fantastic chick hatching experience. The eggs are delivered to our class as part of our 'Crawl, Claws and Growth' topic but the whole school experience the wonder from the minute they are delivered!

Science

In class children will be handling and caring for chicks. They will talk in small groups, learn about the various features of the chicks and understand their life cycle.
