Welcome to Team Ash where we are all becoming responsible, motivated and independent learners, who always help others along the way.

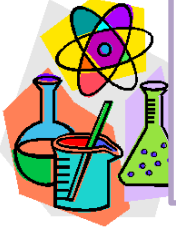
Maths

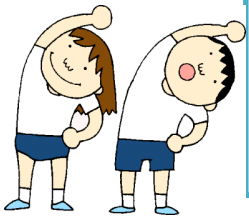


In science and RE...

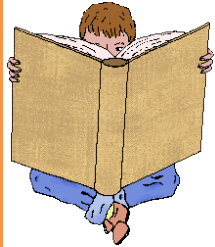


THE TUDOR TIMES
