In maths we encourage children to be all-round mathematicians; including knowledge of number, shape, measure and data handling. This term's focus is to be confident with times tables, place value and shapes.

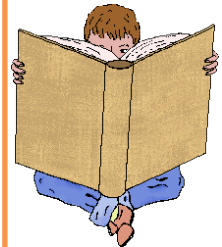


Music

This year, Oak Class will be taking part in ukulele lessons on a Wednesday morning. The children will be divided into small groups who will each receive a half term of tuition.

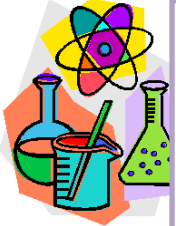
Literacy

We will be learning to narrate, perform and write different text types, our current one being *The Hunter and the Blind Man*. Regular practice of our texts embeds children's learning.

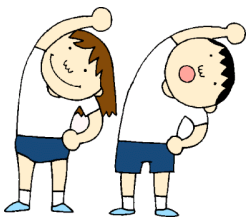


In science and RE...
