Topic/RE

We are exploring the world around us in Geography, talking about our own homes and our local area. In RE, we are discussing Christian Bible stories and their meaning.

Reading/Phonics

Literacy/Science

We are also experimenting with materials in Science. Alongside learning about their properties, we will be investigating which materials are magnetic and waterproof. All perfect for building our very own Tin Forest!
