Welcome to Oak class where we are all becoming responsible, motivated and independent learners, who always help others along the way.

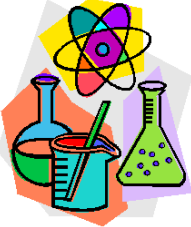
Maths

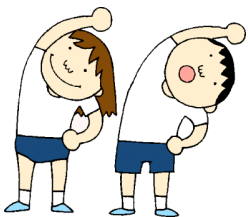


In science and RE...

THE CHOCOLATE RAINFOREST

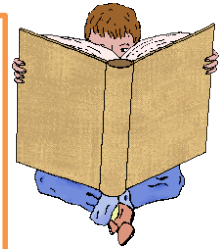
The topic to bridge our learning this term is *The Chocolate Rainforest*. We will discover what life is like for animals and humans living in tropical rainforests. We will learn about current Amazonian tribes as well as studying the mysteries of the Mayan Civilization. This topic will also include an educational trip.

Reading

This term, we will be basing our shared reading sessions on *The Explorer* by Katherine Rundell - an adventure book set in the Amazon rainforest.

Literacy

We will be learning to narrate, perform and write different text types, our current one being *Journey to the River Sea*. Regular practice of our texts embeds children's learning.
