Maths

In maths we are encouraging children to explain mathematical concepts and prove their thinking, both verbally and using physical resources. This term's focus will be on decimals, money, statistics, geometry and time.

In science and RE...

In science, we will learn about Electricity, including circuits, and using this knowledge to build a robot car. In RE, we will be discussing the ways in which the Buddha's teachings make a difference to how Buddhists choose to live, followed by a study of places of worship in Christianity and other religions

Homework, alongside spellings, will be assigned on **Thursdays** and will be due in the following **Monday** in the Log Books. Both **spelling** and **reading** should be practised daily.

Rise of the Robots

The topic to bridge our learning this term is 'Rise of the Robots', through which we will discover all about the origin and use of robotics. We will learn about their history and their impact on the human world, as well as investigate the many different types. Alongside this, we will investigate the science behind them.

Reading

This term, we will be basing our shared reading sessions on the book **Iron Man** by Ted Hughes. Children will be listened to once a week with their own book or in a group.

Literacy

We will be learning to narrate, perform and write different text types, our current one being The 'Teacher Pleser' Machine. Any exposure to different types of non-fiction texts would be very beneficial to the children's understanding of non-fiction writing.
