



Rowan Class Year 6

In **Science** we are looking at electricity and in **RE** we will be looking at the religion of Islam.

Anyone not handing in homework without a valid excuse (e.g. illness) will be required to complete it on a Monday lunch time. There is a weekly homework club 3-4pm on a Thursday if your child needs support to complete homework.

Our Topic until December is **World War Two**: 'We'll meet again'. If you have any resources, books or materials you would like to share with the class or you think will enrich our topic please do send them in! Our class trip this term will be to Didcot Railway Museum on Thursday 26th September to experience a day in the life of an evacuee. We will also have a trip to IMPs at the JR Hospital on Thursday 14th November, and to Junior Citizen on the afternoon of Friday 22nd November. Our class assembly is Friday, 15th November.

Year 6 **Maths** will include revision and deepening of topics covered lower down the school. The children will work on three-step problems, using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They will be encouraged to work independently, deciding themselves on the best method of solving a problem, and then estimating their results and checking to see if they are correct.
