



Statutory Assessments in Primary School

Throughout primary school, children take part in a small number of statutory assessments. These help us understand how they are progressing and where we can support them further. These include:

- **Reception (End of Early Years)** – Good Level of Development
- **Year 1** – Phonics Screening Check
- **Year 2** – A repeat of the Phonics Check for any children who did not meet the standard in Year 1
- **Year 4** – Multiplication Tables Check
- **Year 6 (End of Key Stage 2)** – National tests in Reading, Maths, and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS). Writing is assessed by teachers.

Our Year 6 Results – Summer 2025

We are delighted to share our outcomes from last summer. Our Year 6 children worked incredibly hard, and their results reflect their commitment and the support of our whole school community.

- **Reading, Writing and Maths combined:** 55% achieved the expected standard or above
(*national average: 62%*)
- **Reading:** 63% achieved the expected standard
(*national average: 75%*)
- **Writing:** 66% achieved the expected standard
(*national average: 72%*)
- **Maths:** 68% achieved the expected standard
(*national average: 74%*)
