Please note:

We follow the Local Authority Admission Guidelines. When there are more applications than available places the order of priority is:

1. Looked after children and children with an EHCP or Statement
2. Children (or parent) who have exceptional medical or social needs that make it essential that they attend St Christopher's School rather than any other (must be supported by written evidence from a professional person)
3. Children living within the school catchment area with siblings in the school
4. Children living within the catchment area
5. Children living outside of the school catchment area but with siblings in the school
6. Children living outside of the catchment area.

It will be expected that your child will attend Nursery everyday unless they are ill or there are exceptional circumstances. If your children does not attend for 4 weeks their place will be offered to another child.

If you are paying for nursery hours, fees will still apply even if your child does not attend. Parents will be invoiced half termly.

A nursery place does not guarantee a place in the Reception class; you will need to make a separate application to the Local Authority for a Reception Place. You will receive details about how to apply nearer the time.
