

# Year 4 – Summer 2

## Literacy

We will be exploring the fantasy genre through Aaron Becker's magical picture book 'The Journey' and other classic fantasy texts. We will then write our own fantasy stories and non-chronological reports for an imaginary land.

## Numeracy

We will be focussing on statistics, properties of shape, position and direction this term. We will also continue to develop our number fluency and revise key topics from the year.

## Design Technology

We will be following the DT cycle of research, design, plan, make and evaluate to create our own Roman puppets.

## Computing

This term we will be hardware investigators. We will be investigating the inside of a desktop computer!

## History

We start by studying the expansion of the Roman empire and the Roman invasion of Britain. We then learn about what life was like in Roman Britain and consider the Roman legacy.

## Science

This term we will be developing the scientific skills required in the jobs of botanists, forensic scientists, zoologists, pharmacists and sports scientists to carry out our own investigations.
