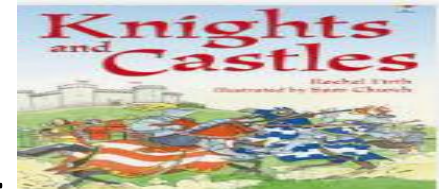


Year 2 – Summer 1



Literacy We will be learning how to write poetry using images of slow objects. We will learn how to write an information text about castles as well as an adventure tale based on 'The Paperbag Princess'. We will learn how to use compound words, suffixes and prefixes and plurals.

Numeracy We will learn to tell the time to the quarter of an hour and to the nearest 5 minutes. We will learn how to describe position, turns and direction. We will learn how to measure in grams and kilograms, litres and millilitres as well as solve measures problems

Art & Design/Design Technology

We will learn about the artist Matisse and create paper collages of castles. We will learn different techniques and create charcoal, paint, chalk, and pencil drawings of castles.

Computing

We will be learning how to use 2sequence to make music and soundtracks. We will create a piece of music to accompany our 'Paperbag Princess' innovated story.

Geography/History

We will learn the parts of a castle and when they were built, who William the Conqueror was, why castles were built and the geographical features of castle locations

Music  We will learn songs about 'Our Land' using Music express. We learn how to sing in groups and use percussion.
