Literacy

We will begin the term looking at building suspense in our writing by using *The Water Tower* by Gary Crew as an example, and then moving on to learning poetry by heart to perform to the class.

Numeracy

Initially, we will be learning about ratio before moving onto imperial and metric measurements before consolidating what we have already covered this year.

Art & Design/Design Technology

Art will be linked to our topic this term and we will produce a series of different images inspired by artists of the time period.

Computing

We will be continuing with our coding work to code our own text adventure stories.

Geography/History

We will introduce our 'Decades' topic with a decade-by-decade study of the changes through the period.

Science

We will be looking at how living things are classified into groups according to common observable characteristics.
